The University of Wollongong (UOW) highly values its ongoing association with The Illawarra Grammar School (TIGS). As a result of our close relationship, UOW is pleased to offer TIGS' enrolled international students the following benefits, to facilitate a smooth transition from high school to UOW:

- Inclusion in the UOW Early Admission program for both HSC and IB students. Successful students receive an offer to UOW before they sit their final exams;
- Three ATAR adjustment points for being a TIGS student;
- A further three additional ATAR Adjustment points for high performance in subjects studied at TIGS that are relevant to the corresponding UOW degree;
- Participation in UOW's Discovery Day program. Discovery Days provide students with the opportunity to experience first-hand what a day at university is like. Students receive a personal timetable and attended lectures as if they were a UOW student;
- Participation in UOW's Summer master Class program (fees apply); benefits of which include:
  - Guaranteed Admissions interview or a conditional offer to study at UOW;
  - Credit towards a UOW degree that could make you eligible for one subject when you study here;
  - Chance to secure a scholarship in your first year at UOW
- Individualised counselling with Admissions and/or Faculty staff to assist with degree choice;
- Access to UOW's co-curricular learning and recognition program, UOWx, which connects students with valuable co-curricular activities. The personal and professional development that students gain through these activities is formally recognised through the UOWx Record and UOWx Award; and
- Access to Careers Central, which assists students to find employment, develop skills, and experience for the workplace. This is offered through internships, voluntary work experience, interview rehearsals and professional resume reviews.
