#### **TIGS PREP**

## Summer Uniform (Term I and Term IV) Girls and Boys

Navy and sky-blue short-sleeve polo shirt with emblem

Navy shorts with emblem

White turn-down socks with sky-blue/navy stripe

TIGS navy hat (girls or boys)

White sports shoes with navy trim

## Winter Uniform (Term II and Term III) Girls and Boys

Navy and sky-blue long-sleeve polo shirt with emblem

Navy TIGS fleece track top with emblem Navy TIGS fleece track pants with emblem White turn-down socks with sky-blue/navy stripe TIGS navy hat (girls or boys)

White sports shoes with navy trim

#### JUNIOR SCHOOL

### Summer Uniform (Term I and Term IV) Girls'

TIGS dress with navy trim (hem to mid-calf) OR TIGS navy shorts and Blue short-sleeve blouse White anklet socks – turned down TIGS navy jumper or TIGS woollen vest TIGS navy girls' hat

#### Boys'

Blue short-sleeve shirt
Grey Junior School tailored shorts

### Winter Uniform (Term II and Term III) Girls'

Illawarra check pinafore (hem to mid-calf) and Blue long-sleeve blouse with burgundy necktie OR TIGS navy pants and Blue long-sleeve blouse Navy knee-high socks or navy school tights TIGS navy jumper or TIGS woollen vest Illawarra grey blazer – Year 3 to Year 6 (optional for Kindergarten to Year 2) Navy scarf and gloves (optional) - TIGS colours TIGS navy girls' hat

#### Boys'

Blue short-sleeve or long-sleeve shirt
Grey Junior School tailored shorts
TIGS blue striped tie
Grey knee high socks with navy and white stripe
TIGS long pants (optional)
TIGS navy jumper or TIGS woollen vest
Illawarra grey blazer – Year 3 to Year 6 (optional for
Kindergarten to Year 2)
Gloves and scarf (optional) - TIGS colours

#### **Sports Uniform**

TIGS navy blue sport polo
TIGS navy sports shorts

TIGS tracksuit
TIGS swimming costume (boys or girls)

House polo shirt
Sport shoes - predominately white

#### PERSONAL ATTITUDES AND APPEARANCE

There is an obligation upon all students to wear the appropriate uniform correctly and neatly, including at after-hours events and meetings, whether at school or off-site. All articles of the student's clothing are to be labelled with the pupil's name and parents are asked to ensure students come to school correctly attired and neatly dressed. High personal standards are required of all students and are recognised in the Personal Presentation Award. This award is available to all students who display a commitment to excellence in personal presentation and behaviour and is a prerequisite to holding any leadership position in the student body.

#### **Hair Styles**

- At all times, hair is to be clean and tidy.
- Hair cannot be coloured.
- Hairstyles must not be extreme. The following examples provide specific guidelines for both boys and girls. However, if you are not sure what is acceptable, check with the School beforehand.
- The School reserves the right to instruct any student to conform to hair regulations.

#### Boys

- Hair is to be above the collar, not covering eyes and off the ears.
- Hair is not to be shaved or have shaved patterns or lines. It should be no shorter than a number 3 clipper.
- Hair is not to be tied back.

#### Girls

• Long hair (below the collar), must be tied back with a regulation ribbon or scrunchie, as supplied by the Uniform Shop.

#### Jewellery

- Jewellery, nail polish, makeup or earrings must not be worn by any student.
- If a female student has pierced ears then the smallest, most plain 'stud', or 'sleeper' earring may be worn, one in each lobe only.
- No visible tattoos or body piercing.

#### **Shoes**

- Firm Black leather lace-up, to be clean and polished at all times, which are to have a flat sole, and no more than a 2cm heel. (Joggers or skate shoes in black are not allowed).
- Predominately white joggers for P.E. and sports days (Junior School only).

#### **Blazers**

• Blazers must be worn by Year 3 to Year 12 students travelling to and from school and in public during the winter semester.

TIGS Back Packs are required for all students as purchased from the Uniform Shop.

TIGS Prep and Junior School students are required to have a TIGS Navy Library Bag and plain yellow raincoat.

For official school functions or activities, the School will advise parents as to whether Summer or Winter Uniform is required – irrespective of the season in which the function is to be held.

TIGS has a Uniform Shop on site which is open for parents and students during term time on Tuesdays and Thursdays between 8.30am and 4.00pm. During Holiday periods, days and times will vary - please phone the School or visit TIGS website for confirmation of opening times.
