
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

Personal Attitudes and Appearance

There is an obligation upon all students to wear the appropriate uniform correctly and neatly, including at after-hours events and meetings, whether at school or off-site. All articles of the student's clothing are to be labelled with the pupil's name and parents are asked to ensure students come to school correctly attired and neatly dressed. Excellence in personal presentation and behaviour is a prerequisite for holding any leadership position in the student body.

Hair Styles

- At all times, hair is to be clean and tidy.
- Hairstyles must be conservative and natural in colour
- Bold styles are not permitted. This may include:
 - Hair that has noticeably been coloured
 - Lines that have been cut in with a razor
 - Undercuts
 - Mullet-style cuts.
- If you are not sure what is acceptable, check with the School beforehand. The School reserves the right to instruct any student to conform to hair regulations. The following examples provide specific guidelines for both boys and girls.

BOYS

- Hair is to be above the collar, not covering eyes and off the ears.
- Hair is not to be shaved. It should be no shorter than number 3 clipper.
- Hair is not to be tied back.
- Face must be clean shaven.
- Sideburns must not extend below the ear and should be neatly trimmed.

GIRLS

- Long hair (below the collar), must be tied back with a regulation ribbon or scrunchie, as supplied by the Uniform Shop.
- Length of skirts and dresses are to fall just below the knee.

Jewellery

- Jewellery, nail polish or makeup must not be worn by any student.
- If a student has pierced ears then the smallest, most plain stud earring may be worn, one in each lobe only.
- No visible tattoos or body piercing.

Shoes

Firm black leather lace-up, to be clean and polished at all times, which are to have a flat sole, and no more than a 2cm heel. Joggers or skate shoes in black are not allowed.

Blazers

- Blazers must be worn by Year 3 to Year 12 students travelling to and from school and in public during the winter semester.
- Blazers are to be worn to Chapel and Assembly in summer and winter and also at official school functions.

TIGS Back Packs are required for all students as purchased from the Uniform Shop.

TIGS Pre-K/Prep and Junior School students are required to have a TIGS Navy Library Bag and plain navy raincoat.

For official school functions or activities, the School will advise parents as to whether Summer or Winter Uniform is required – irrespective of the season in which the function is to be held.
